The primary purpose of this role is to carry out football attendance duties within parks establishments.

Games Attendant Duties & Responsibilities:

- Key duties and responsibilities include:
 - Opening and closing sports pavilions as required, before, during, and after play.
 - Operating heating and lighting systems within the pavilion as necessary.
 - Ensuring high standards of cleanliness for all changing, shower, and toilet facilities.
 - Maintaining a clean and litter-free immediate exterior of the pavilion and ensuring football pitches are clear of litter after each game.
 - Reporting any littering issues or property damage to the Area Manager on the same working day.
 - Being available on-site throughout the period of attendance
 - Directing teams towards their allocated pitches as needed
 - Reporting any defects of the facilities to the area parks office

Communication, Engagement and Training:

- Available on-site throughout the period of attendance.
- Direct teams towards their allocated pitches as required.
- Responsible for reporting any defects of the facilities to the area parks office.

 Adhere to and comply with all relevant corporate policies and procedures including Health & Safety, General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), Corporate Governance and Code of Conduct.
